Annual Report (2020- 2021)

Vision of the institute:

To make Government College Dera Bassi a quality zone by imparting quality education at all levels to produce 'children of substance' who can face challenges of globalization in the 21 st century.

Mission of the Institute

Mission of create young minds with the sense to self evaluative accountability chisel them in the socially responsible, morally up-right innovative citizens who can contribute constructively to the task of nation building.

Objectives of the Institute:

To ensure the holistic development of the students, so that they can contribute toward nation building **Location of the Institute:**

Government College Derabassi situated at a distance of 700 meters from Chandigarh-Ambala road and surrounded by lush forest and natural environment. It started working on 15th January, 1975 with the efforts of the then local MLA and Finance Minister Shri Hans Raj Sharma ji in the premises of the primary school building of Derabassi town. In the first year only 126 students got admission in the college. On 7 February 1984, the college shifted to its present building. Established in a natural environment like Shanti Niketan, this college has been setting goals for development since the last 43 years and has become an important institution meeting the needs of higher education in this area adjacent to Haryana and Puadh area of Punjab. Along with. It is also providing a new direction in the social, cultural and economic fields and has emerged as a beacon of light to provide consciousness in surrounding rural areas. In view of the achievements and facilities of this institution, NAAC awarded B+" grade to it. in February 2004 and "B" grade in February 2016.

Earlier the college had partial online admission process in which only applications were received online. But this year due to Covid-19 as per instructions of UGC, to make entire admission process online to minimize the students' visits to the college in view of the situation arising out of the coronavirus pandemic, the admission branch of the college worked towards strengthening the process from August onwards. The verification of certificates and generation of fee challans was also completed online. Apply link was created on college website www.gcderabassi.ac.in and they were registered through Login Id/Application Number and Password and they were instructed to send scanned copies of their required

documents Fee challan was also sent to them at their email Id or their WhatsApp no. and they were given all information on how to submit their fee online.



Extra efforts done by the College due to Corona impact:

This year due to Corona going out at peak the college remained closed from March 2020 to July 2020. All the activities were being handled online. The colleges started from 1st August but the college academic activities had to be done online according to the SOPs issued by the Government of India. It was requirement of the time to keep students safe and to build an environment that's inclusive of everyone. The faculty had to be adequately provided training to online teaching tools and platforms. The college opted for Google meet and the attendance of teaching Faculty was taken through Google forms. As per U.G.C instructions 25-40% of the syllabus was completed online. Challenges had been acute as the Wi-Fi speed needed updation. Video conferencing facilities had to be provided to teachers to which many of teachers were not accustomed to. Thus to provide exposure to Practicals and laboratory equipments, the students were provided online lessons. Under highly stressful conditions' teachers and students were returning to classrooms amid the pandemic although with all the precautionary measures to be adopted as per government rules. As the students belong to rural areas where Wi- Fi facility is not that Good and virtual education was not working for them, such students had to be accommodated to class room study for their difficulties. Teachers/ faculty however soon got adaptable to the resilient educational system during pandemic and tried their best to make remote learning effective and kept proper feedback about learning on part of students

Student' strength of the session:

During the session 2020-21, 1449 students had been studying in the college, out of which 686 were boys and 763 were girls. A total of 905 students were in Arts Faculty, 414 boys and 491 girls. A total of 198 students were in the Faculty of Commerce. Out of which 70 were boys and 128 were girls and total 77 students were studying in science faculty out of which 42 were boys and 35 were girls. HEIS courses started by the college got full response. A total of 170 students were enrolled in B. Com.(Honours)

classes running under this scheme. Out of which 95 were boys and 75 were girls and in BCA total of 99 students got enrolled out of which 65 were boys and 34 were girls.

The college admissions were done through various admission committees as per the instructions of the Education Department and the University rules so that a total of 441 students of SC category got admission in the college out of which 205 were males and 236 females and under backward category. 199 males and 212 females got admission.

Conduct of College House exams and University Examination:

This year Planning of examinations also required appropriate measures because generic measures had to be followed to reduce the risk of COVID-19. The examination Branch of the College under the Registrar Associate Professor Savita Gupta along with her team Prof. Saloni, Dr. Prabhjot Kaur, Dr. Sumita Katoch, Prof. Avtar Singh, Prof. Ravinder Jit organized House examinations as well as University examinations of all classes in the college from time to time with the sincere cooperation of the entire staff following the rules of the affiliating University and the SOPs issued by the Government of India. Online exams, assignments and Practicals were held this year and discipline deployed and observance to distancing norms and other preventive measures at all times was ensured while collection of papers and conduct of the examination. A staggered manner was followed .so as to avoid overcrowding at the

college on any day. Thus, exams were held in a very peaceful environment. Special examinations were also organized to enable the students to fulfil the eligibility requirements of the universities.

Total number of teachers: -

The total number of teachers in the college during the session was 29. Among them 07 had been regular, 16 guest faculty teachers worked under PTA and 06 Guest faculty worked under HEIS.

Library service and other facilities: -

During the session 2020-21 the number of books available in library stood at 17646. A total of 10 newspapers and 10 magazines came in the library during the session. A book bank has been established in the college library owing to the efforts of Prof. Manohar Kaur, retd. Head of the Hindi Department. It has 547 books at present. 156 books pertaining to career guidance are there in the library. From the book bank, books are given to the poor and needy students of the college every year for the entire semester.

College Magazine:-

Vidya Pradeep magazine is published every year keeping in mind the literary interests of the students and to bring out the creative talent hidden in them. The college magazine for the year 2021-22 is ready to be published under the supervision of Associate Professor Navdeep Kahol, Editor-in-Chief.

Parents- Teachers Association (PTA):-

Parents of all students of the college and teachers are members of PTA and they contribute a lot financially to help the institute. Almost three to four meetings are held every year with constituted members. This association strives for the progress of students at the social, academic and cultural level throughout the academic session. Seventeen guest faculty teachers have been hired from PTA fund to teach different classes in the college.

Higher Education Institute Society (HEIS): -

Two Self-financing courses B. Com. (Honours) and B.C. A. ar in India's unique festivals, e being run under HEIS. 06 teachers working as guest faculty to teach the students of above courses and are paid through HEIS. Two computer labs are successively running under the establishment in which 30 computers have been installed and 05 laptops have also been provided to faculty through HEIS. A separate library is functional under HEIS and almost 1600 books have been kept to cater to the students' needs.

Old Student Association (OSA) or Alumni association: -

Old Student Association is quite active in the college and is continuously working for the welfare of the current students and the betterment of the entire institution. Many activities in the college are

supported by the old students. Rs. 2100/- Cash prize and trophy are given every year to the best student by this foundation.. A new election of this organization was held in the month of April in which Shri Ranjit Singh Reddy was elected as President.

Special Prizes for the Students:

In order to honor the winners and talented students and to encourage and felicitate them for their outstanding achievements in different spheres, special prizes are given away every year by College Administration, OSA, Vinod Paul Memorial Trust Dera-Bassi, Rotary Club Dera-Bassi, Past Students and various Social Service Organizations, Ex-Principals of the College, Professors and Ex-Professors or their families in various areas of the College.. Different prizes given every year by various organizations or individuals are as below.

- Rotary Club Dera Bassi confers a cash prize of Rs. 2100/- to the best student of the college.
- A trophy is given to the best student by the OSA. Best Student is selected on the basis of allround achievement in the three year degree course from Arts, Commerce and Science streams.
- Vinod Pal Memorial trust, Dera Bassi gives away a trophy and cash prize to the students from the commerce stream. A cash prize of Rs. 500/-, Rs. 1100/- and Rs. 2100/- respectively is given to the student who stands first in the college in the B.Com Sem II, annual exam of the University, B.Com IVth Sem and B.Com Sem VIth of the University respectively. If a student stands first in the annual exam in the university in any of the three years, he/she is given a trophy and a cash prize of Rs. 5100/-.
- Prof. I.S Sukhi (Retd.) in the memory of his late wife Mrs. Surjit Sukhi gives away a cash prize of Rs. 2500/- to the student who secures more than 60% marks or stands first in the B.Sc Sem II annual exams.
- Pratap Trophy and cash prize of Rs. 500/- is given every year by Prof I.S Sukhi to the best athlete (boys) of the college and Basant trophy and Rs. 500/- to the best athlete (girls) in memory of his late father and mother respectively.
- An FDR of the amount of Rs. 2100/- has been secured in the name of the college by our Ex-Principal Mrs. Vipan Sobti and Ex-Principal Mrs. Reeta Gangahar. A Cash prize is given every year to the outstanding student of the college from this amount.
- A cash prize is given by Principal Mrs. Pawinder Kaur to B.Com(Hons)/ B.Com Prof. students who stand first in Sem II, IV,VI.
- In the memory of Late Prof. Paramdeep Singh Bhullar a sum of Rs. 11000/- has been deposited in the Bank by his family. Prof. Paramdeep Singh Bhullar award is given every year to the student who stands first in the B.A IIIrd year annual exam from this amount.
- A cash Prize of Rs. 1100/- each and a trophy is given every year to the students who stand first in the annual exams of B.A III, B.Sc Sem VI and B.Com Sem VI by Sardar Gurdarshan Singh, Chairman S. Gurnam Singh and Co.

- By the Former President of OSA and students Union, Sh. Dhanwant Singh, in memory of his late daughter Biba Gurpreet Kaur, a cash prize of Rs. 500 is given to students who stand second in B.Com VI, BA III and B.Sc VI.
- A Cash Prize of Rs. 500/- each is given by Prof. L.D Tayal (Retd.) every year to the best player male and female.
- An FDR to the amount of Rs. 21000/- has been secured in the name of the college by our Ex-Principal Mrs. Reeta Gangahar, out of which cash prize is given to the students who perform well in co-curricular activities.
- The prize for the maximum attendance is given every year to the student who gets more than 90% attendance.
- The prize for the best reader is given every year to a student of the college on the recommendation of our librarian. backward belt of Punjab. Keeping in view the facilities being provided to the students

Important Note:

In order to be eligible for the above prizes, it is necessary that the prize-winning student's lectures should not be less, the studies should be satisfactory and the conduct of the student should be good.

Educational Tour: -

Along with studies in the college, educational tours are also conducted for the students, but due to the 2020-21 Corona epidemic, no educational tours were conducted under the government directives.

NATIONAL ASSESSMENT AND ACCREDITATION COUNCIL (NAAC):

Our college had received 'B' grade from NAAC in February 2016-17. The NAAC/IQAC committee is constituted every year as per guidelines of NAAC. Currently, the annual quality assurance team has five staff members (Prof. Navdeep Kahol, Prof. Saloni, Prof. Kanu Garg, Prof. Ravinderjit, Prof. Jaytika) and 2 important members of the society. and AQAR to be sent to NAAC every year is under preparation.

UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION (U.G.C.)

The college didn't receive any grant from the UGC under XIII Grant scheme (2017 -2022) The college had received grant of six lakh forty thousand under XII Grant scheme (2012-2016), for which the audit was conducted by Comptroller and auditor General Chandigarh during the session and a satisfactory audit report was granted for the spent amount except for interest amount.

 Punjab Education Recruitment Board PPSC and various local industries and businesses were shared with students through posters, WhatsApp & Telegram groups.


N.S.S. Department:







Under "Clean India, Green India" project, the students were made aware about Government Mission of Plastic free India environment and a lecture was delivered to them on the topic.

Punjabi Department:-


